Legacy Ag Credit is offering funding opportunities for Texas FFA Chapters and 4-H Clubs that reside within our service area.





Legacy Ag Credit is dedicated to supporting agriculture and rural communities. Each year, we will award up to \$5,000 in grant funds to outstanding organizations with a passion for agriculture.

Goal

To assist local agricultural programs and promote Legacy Ag Credit.

Guidelines

Grant applications are accepted annually from September 1st to November 15th. All applications and supporting documents must be submitted by November 15th to be considered for funding in January. Legacy Ag Credit will award grants to Texas FFA chapters and 4-H clubs to support approved projects or facility improvements. Grants may cover up to 75% of the total project cost.

Eligibility Requirements

To qualify, chapters/clubs must:

- Reside in Legacy Ag Credit's 10-county territory (Franklin, Gregg, Harrison, Hopkins, Kaufman, Marion, Rains, Upsher, Van Zandt, Wood)
- Provide a letter from the superintendent and/or additional funding sources.
- Submit a complete application, including a statement of need and detail of proposed project, by the required deadline.

NOTE: Grants will fund up to 75% of the proposed project. Projects must be completed by September 1st of the funding year, with a progress report submitted in May of the same year.
